**Herkner Road, East Long Lake Road to North Long Lake Road. Long Lake Township. FLAGGING OPERATIONS.**

**Williamsburg Road. Whitewater Township. LANE CLOSURE.**

- Mainline paving and shoulder work
- Lane closures will continue as the project proceeds.
