Traverse City.

Weather permitting, this is Grand Traverse County Road Commission's updated road construction report as of May 26, 2017. This notice is prepared on information supplied by our contractor and staff.

Bluff Road, Peninsula Township.

- *Shoulder work and restoration work will follow.
- *Road closed with traffic directed by flagging operations.

M-113, Kingsley Village Limits to M-37. Paradise and Mayfield Townships.

- *High ridges along the road edges are being removed and hauled away.
- *Residents should remove/secure any damageable items located within the right-of-way.
- * Work will begin at the Kingsley village limits and move westerly to M-37.
- *Traffic will be directed by flaggers as this operation moves along its route.
- *Motorists should anticipate delays and schedule routes and times accordingly.

Oak Terrace Drive, off Garfield. Garfield Township

- *Ongoing lane closures associated with water main and sewer installation.
- *Lane closure directed by flag control.

West Front Street, Cedar Run Road to city limits of Traverse City.

- *The east/northbound lane will be shifted to the center lane.
- *DTE is working on a gas main.
- *The lane shift will begin at Cedar Run Road and continue to the city limits.
- *Work resumes on Tuesday, May 30, through Friday, June 2.
- * The lane shift will be in place 24 hours/day.
- *Motorists should drive with caution as they maneuver around the work zone.

GTCRC Maintenance Activities

- *Grading - Seasonal roads.
- *Pothole patching – just about everywhere.

***MOTORISTS: Traffic will be directed by flaggers through the lane closures.
Please plan ahead or use alternate routes as delays are likely.***
