Traverse City.

Weather permitting, this is Grand Traverse County Road Commission's updated road construction report as of June 9, 2017. This notice is prepared on information supplied by our contractor and staff.

As of FRIDAY, JUNE 9

North Arbutus Lake Road. From East Arbutus to Four Mile Rd. East Bay Township.

- *Crush-and-shape portion of the work is back on its original start date of Monday, June 12.
- *Perishable items located within the road right-of-way should be relocated to avoid damage from operations.
- *This project is scheduled to take 18 work days.
- *Motorists will encounter lane closures under flag control and should anticipate delays.

SATURDAY & SUNDAY, JUNE 10 & 11

Oak Terrace Drive, Garfield Road to the West. Garfield Township

- *Contractor will pave Oak Terrace on Saturday and Sunday, June 10 and 11.
- *Lane closure with traffic directed via flag control.
- *Motorists should anticipate delays.

Maple Terrace. Peninsula Township.

- *Continued utility work this week.
- *Lane closures will be directed by flaggers.

Various County Roads

- *Special Markings (RR, School, etc.) will continue this week in various locations throughout the county.
- *Watch for cones along the newly painted areas to avoid paint splatter on vehicles.

GTCRC Maintenance Activities

- *Mowing - along state highways
- *Shoulder Work - East Bay and Garfield Townships.
- *Shoulders will be closed and traffic will be directed by flaggers as this operation moves along its route.
- *Grading - Seasonal roads.
- *Durapatching - River Road bridge decks and other sites in East Bay Township.
- *Pothole patching – just about everywhere.

***MOTORISTS: Traffic will be directed by flaggers through the lane closures.
Please plan ahead or use alternate routes as delays are likely.***
