Traverse City.

The following work has been scheduled by the Grand Traverse County Road Commission. All work is weather dependent. Motorists must obey traffic controllers and reduce their speed as they travel through the work zone.

Wednesday, June 7, 2017

SmartCommute Bike Tour on Three Mile Road. East Bay Township.

- *Between 7-7:30 AM, a bike tour with police escort will be traveling Three Mile Road.
- *Tour will begin at South Airport and travel south ending at Hammond Road.
- *The road is open to traffic.
- *Motorist should “share” the road and anticipate potential delays.

Guardrail Removal/Replacement Work. Paradise and Long Lake Townships.

- *On Wednesday, June 7, crews will be removing and replacing guardrail in three locations.
- * Work is expected to last between two and three hours at each site.
- *Starting at 9 AM, crews be at:
 - A. Garfield Road, north of the Village of Mayfield, then travel to:
 - B. Near 8188 North Long Lake Road which is by Coffield Lake near Hall’s Farm Market, then travel to:
 - C. Strait Road near Cedar Run Road.
- * Motorists will encounter lane closures and should anticipate delays.

Friday, June 9, 2017

North Arbutus Road Project. East Bay Township.

- *Crush-and-shape portion of the work is starting earlier than announced and will begin on Friday, June 9.
- *Perishable items located within the road right-of-way should be relocated to avoid damage from operations.
- *This project is scheduled to take 18 work days.
- *Motorists will encounter lane closures under flag control and should anticipate delays.
