Traverse City.

Weather permitting, this is Grand Traverse County Road Commission's updated road construction report as of June 30, 2017. This notice is prepared on information supplied by our contractor and staff.

East Long Lake Road, from Secor to North Long Lake. Long Lake Township.

- *This work is scheduled to begin July 10.
- *A detour will be required as part of the project.
- *The entire section will be resurfaced.
- *A section between Huellmantel and North Long Lake will be crushed and shaped, along with some guardrail improvements.

North Arbutus Lake Road. From East Arbutus to Four Mile Road Intersection. East Bay Township.

- *Restoration work remains to be done.
- *Motorists may encounter lane closures under flag control.

Oak Terrace Drive, Garfield Road to the West. Garfield Township

- *Any remaining paving work will be addressed.
- *Restoration work will be performed.
- *Lane closure with traffic directed via flag control.
- *Motorists should anticipate delays.

Strait Road, North Long Lake to Cedar Run. Long Lake Township

- *This work is scheduled to begin July 10.
- *A detour route will be required.

GTCRC Maintenance Activities

- *Mowing Grant, Garfield and Green Lake Townships.
- *Shoulder Work Long Lake and Garfield Townships. Shoulders will be closed and traffic will be directed by flaggers as this operation moves along its route.
- *Grading gravel roads where necessary.
- *Durapatching Whitewater and East Bay Townships.
- *Tree Work Whitewater and East Bay Townships.
- *Pothole patching just about everywhere.

MOTORISTS: Traffic will be directed by flaggers through the lane closures.

Please plan ahead or use alternate routes as delays are likely.
